

Form A Union

As Public Sector workers, we've watched service become more of a business at the expense of our community and ourselves. Now more than ever, we need to join together and advocate for better public services and that puts the community before profits.

In Ohio, and around the country, growing numbers of public employees are forming unions. Forming a union guarantees we are heard because we speak with one unified voice. By working together as a group, rather than going it alone, we can work with our employers to address key issues and concerns in our workplace including:

A Voice on the Job -- A union gives caregivers a say in how the workplace operates. We can sit down with administrators and supervisors to work out solutions as equals.

Better Staffing and Quality Services – We can establish better staffing guidelines and more reasonable workloads, preserve professional standards and stand up for quality public services.

Higher Pay and Regular Raises – This means guaranteed rewards for hard work and a pay system that recognizes longevity and the cost of living.

Benefits we can Count on – We can negotiate and protect the health insurance, vacation, sick leave and other benefits our families need most.

Job Security and Representation – We can set fair rules and bring employment security into our workplaces. We can also speak out about problems on the job without fear of reprisals and have a seat at the table when cost-cutting, contracting-out and other decisions are made.

Community Involvement – Rather than leaving all the decisions about vital public services to be decided without community involvement, we're coming together to address key issues and concerns through negotiated contracts, legislative, and community outreach.
